


## Lorimer

## **Consumption - Crisp - Export**

Lorimer is a cream-fleshed and yellow-skinned variety. This mid-late variety produces round to oval tubers ideal to transform into chips. Its regular size and high dry matter are assets for manufacturers. Its crisp colours are great and its low level of reducing sugars allows it to avoid colorations. Lorimer has good foliage and is robust in terms of harsh weather conditions Finally, Lorimer is a variety that can be stored on a long-term basis.
