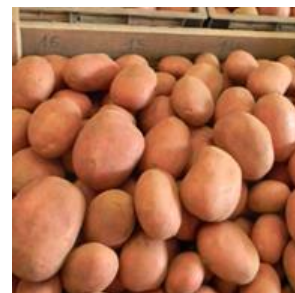


## Consumption – Fresh market – Export

Mid-early variety with a beautiful red color, it is resistant to the nematode Ro1-4 and provides a high yield with the production of large sizes. Its beautiful skin color makes it a variety adapted to washing for packers.
